# Recreational Fishing



- Increased rec fishing effort throughout the calendar year
  - increased effort on select locations and species (e.g., striped bass)
  - real-time social media fishing posts
- Impacts on the resource?
- Fishery management implications?

- **Potential CESS task:** Determine whether rec species are experiencing increased effort from year-round fishing; quantify economic impacts by species, regions with greatest changes

# Standard Social and Economic Indicators



- Standard SE indicators could provide a comprehensive understanding of each fishery
- Trends in prices, participant demographics, directed trips, and discards vs. harvest



# Standard Social and Economic Indicators



- Ex: American Lobster 2020 Stock Assessment

	< 25 <sup>th</sup> percentile	Between 25 <sup>th</sup> and 75 <sup>th</sup> percentile	> 75 <sup>th</sup> percentile
Number of traps (effort; partial)	Positive	Neutral	Negative
Total stock landings (lbs, all sources)	Negative	Neutral	Positive
Partial landings (lbs, sources with corresponding effort data)	Negative	Neutral	Positive
Gross CPUE (partial landings/traps)	Negative	Neutral	Positive
Price per pound (US Average)	Negative	Neutral	Positive
Revenue (based on total stock landings)	Negative	Neutral	Positive
Revenue per trap (based on gross CPUE)	Negative	Neutral	Positive
