Basic Guidelines: In consideration of the Commission's budget please attempt to select the most reasonable

airfare. You are responsible for determining your arrival and departure times. Commissioners (or their proxies) are eligible to attend all meetings; all others are eligible for reimbursement to attend board/committee meetings of which they are a member. If the distance from your office to the meeting site is under 35 miles, ASMFC will not reimburse hotel, mileage or per diem but may reimburse any miscellaneous expenses that would not normally occur during a work day (i.e., parking, tolls). ASMFC reserves the right to disallow travel expenses it deems excessive or

unnecessary to conduct ASMFC business.

Parking: Hotel offers valet parking only at \$26.00/day (NO in/out privileges). A recommended alternative

is Colonial Parking Garage 551 John Carlyle St. near the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office \$10/

day (Open 24hrs).
