

Addendum VI



- >F_{target} = 0.15 to rebuild the stock; 53% harvest redux from 2008 & 2009 avg.
- Carried over language allowing for regional/state assessments at "same level of precision" as coastwide assessment.
 - Approved states required to give annual update as part of compliance report.
- > January 1, 2012 Implementation





Previous Board Meetings

- \triangleright Approved MA/RI VPA (F = 0.12)
 - "Precision" MSR = 0.69 vs. 0.61 for coastwide
 - History of proactive management
- > Approved reduction <u>methodology</u> for CT, NY, NJ, DE, MD, & VA
 - Based on calculations for specific methods.
 - Given TC caveats.
- > Approved catch curve (CC) state assessments for NY (48.7%), NJ (unknown), MD (49%), & VA (50.5%)



December – January 2012

- > All states have submitted proposals
 - Last two proposals submitted January 31, 2012
 - Insufficient time for full PRT review
 - LEC will review in early 2012
- > Preliminary review only
- ➤ All state proposals sans NJ comply with methods from TC reviewed proposals
- ➤ NJ commercial size increase reviewed by TC on December 19, 2011
- > Regulations table in memo



Connecticut




- >53% total reduction
- ➤ Effective January 23, 2012
- ➤ New closed season February 1 April 30 in both fisheries





New York



- >48.7% reduction
- > Recreational
 - Additional closures: Jan. 17 − Apr. 30, Oct. 1
 −7, & Dec. 4 − 20
 - 16" size limit (+2")
- **Commercial**
 - Additional closures: Jan. 1 Feb 28 & Apr. 8
 Dec. 31
 - **15"** size limit (+1")



Delaware



- >53% Reduction
- ➤ Effective February 11, 2012
- **Consistent rec. and com.**
- \triangleright Reduced bag limit to 5 (-5, +2)
- **▶ 16 day additional closure in Wave 4**
- **►** Increased size to 16" (+1,2")





Maryland



- >48.8% reduction (catch curve)
- > Expected to be effective April 2, 2012
- **Consistent rec. and com.**
- **>**16" Size limit (+2")
- ➤ Additional 16-day Wave 6 closure





Virginia



- >50.5% reduction (catch curve)
- ➤ Effective January 1, 2012
- > Recreational regulations
 - **■** Size increase to 16" (+2)
 - Possession limit 3 fish (-1)
 - Additional 106 day closure (Wave 2 4)
- > Commercial regulations
 - Additional 57 day closure (Wave 1 & 5)
 - Commercial size increase to 15" (+1)



New Jersey



- >53% reduction
- ➤ Effective Jan. 25, 2012
- > Recreational
 - 15" size limit
 - Additional closures: Mar. 1 31, July 10 16, July 17 -26, Sept. 1 – Oct. 16.
 - 4 fish (-2) Nov 16. Dec. 31
- **Commercial**
 - 15" size limit
 - Additional closures: June 6 21 & Nov 1 –




TC Review of NJ Commercial Size Increase

- ➤ NJ Advisors requested commercial size increases after November Board meeting
- ➤ Commercial size increase not included in suite of options from approved NJ proposal
- >NJ DEP requested TC review
- ➤ TC reviewed in December 2011, recommended approval
- > Effective Jan. 25, 2012



NJ Com. Size Increase



- ➤ Apply the recreational size limit data to the commercial fishery
- **▶** Uses the MAFMC SAS code
- > TC is comfortable with the approach
- Similar to NY & CT
- ➤ Recommend maximum 44% reduction from size limits (9% buffer)
 - 9% consistent w/ neighboring DE, TC did not want to pick arbitrary buffer
- ➤ Final reg. package 29% of total commercial reduction from size increase
- > TC Recommends Board approve



Board Action?



➤ Approve NJ commercial size limit harvest reduction proposal.
